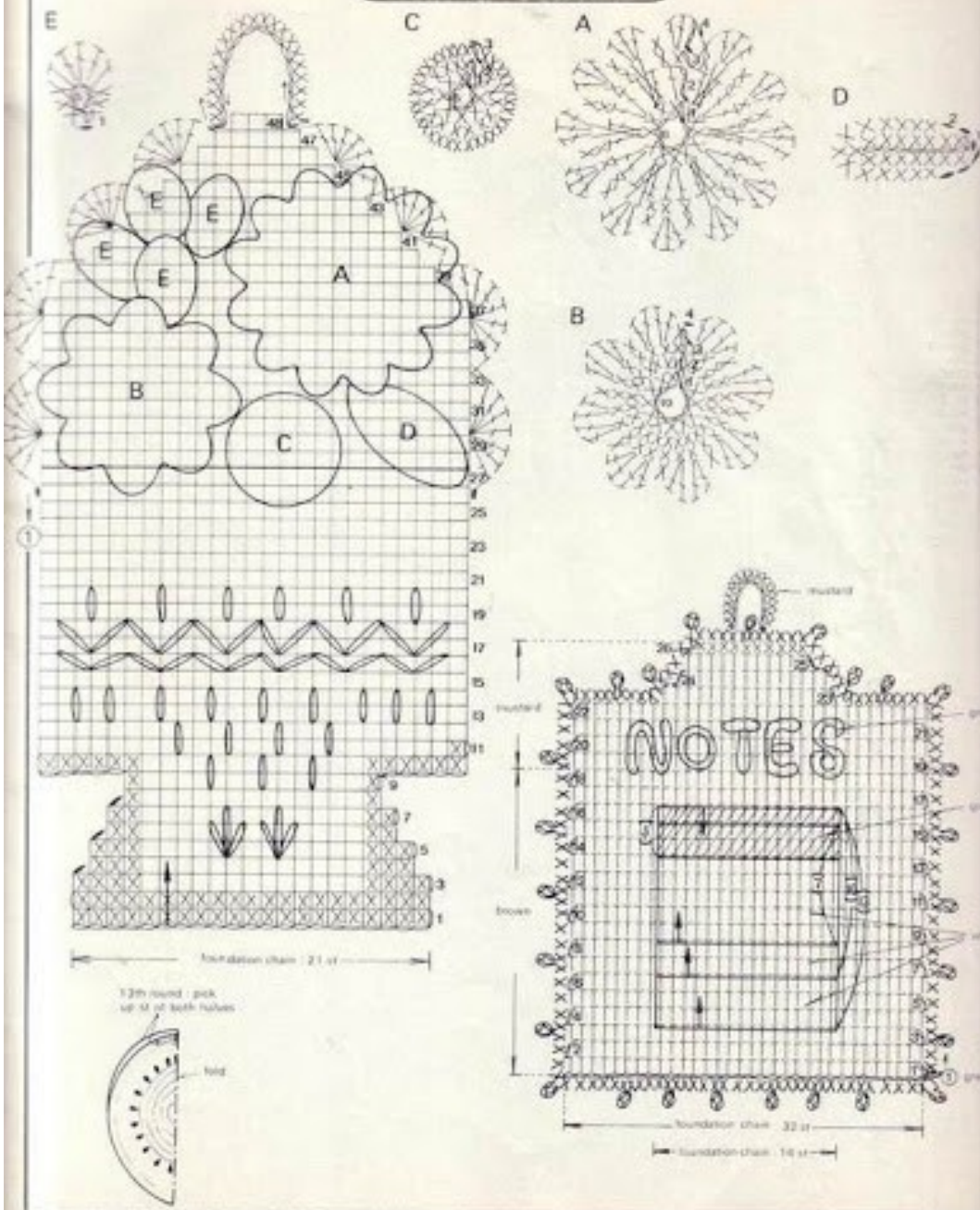


MAGIC CROCHET



2 A BIT OF ORIGINALITY FOR YOUR KITCHEN



MATERIALS: For kettle holder A, some lengths of medium thick cotton yarn, in green, light green, pink, light pink, black - a no. 200 crochet hook - for kettle holder B - a few lengths of corded cotton no. 3, ivory and red - a no. 1.75 crochet hook (English no. 1.5 or 2.00 crochet hook) - for kettle holder C - some twisted cotton in green, white, mustard and brown - a no. 3.75 crochet hook (English no. 1.50 or 2.00) - for kettle holder D - some lengths of twisted cotton in blue, white, navy blue, red, pink, black, brown and light green - a no. 1.75 crochet hook (English no. 1.50 or 2.00).

MEASUREMENTS: A - diameter 14.5 cm (5.75 in) - B - one side is 10 cm (3.75 in) and C - 14 x 12.5 cm (5.12 x 4.78 in) - D - 16 x 10 cm (6.14 x 3.78 in).

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS: **KETTLE HOLDER A** - Make 8 st with pink yarn and join to form a ring with 1 st. 1st round: 14 dc into ring, always make 1 ch to replace 1st dc of a round; finish off this round of round with 1 sc into 1st ch at beg. & 2nd-5th rounds: 4 dc, etc. as

shown in chart. In 10th round, rep. *2 st with pink yarn, 2 st with black yarn into following st*, and with 1 dc in pink yarn and finish off with 1 sc into 1st round. Beg. 12th round with 1 ch and make 1 sc into each st up to 11th round inclusive (1 - 11 st); finish off each round with 1 sc into ch at beg. and change color as shown in chart. 14-17th round: work 9 in. evenly spaced - 120 st. 18th round: Fold work in half and pick up at same time the corresponding st of both halves; make 1 sc into each st. Loop - After finishing 14th round, without breaking off yarn, cont. by making 10, 8, 6, 4, and double back with 14 sc into loop, 1 sc into last sc of 14th round, make 1 ch and break off yarn. **KETTLE HOLDER B** - Make a chain of 12 st with extra yarn. 1st row: 1 ch to replace 1st dc, row starting with

9th st from hook make 1 dc into each st, 2nd-4th rows: 4 dc and so in 7th round, etc. in corner of 10th round, as shown in chart. 15th row: After finishing 14th row, without turning work over, work 1 ch and so all around; finish off round with 1 sc into 1st st; make 1 ch and break off yarn. Finishing: Join red yarn with 1 sc into corner of 1st loop; make 11 ch, 1 sc into same st as previous one, and rep. *5 dc into following 10th st, 1 sc into following 1st st*, finish with 1 sc into next st. 17 sc into loop, 1 sc into st of loop and break off yarn. Decorating ribbon - Make a chain with red yarn, fit round it through 1 dc, use chart, 10 and sew with invisible st. **KETTLE HOLDER C** - 1st row: Work back along a chain of 21 st making 2 ch and starting with 4th st from hook make 1 hdc into each st. 2nd-25th rows: Work straight on, with hdc, changing color as shown in chart. 26th row: Join yarn with 1 sc into 9th st, make 2 ch and 15 hdc. 26th-25th rows: Work back with 2 sc into last 2 st, then cont. with hdc, as shown in chart. 26th row: Work back with 1 sc into last st, then make 1 ch and 10 sc. Break off yarn. Finishing: With green yarn, beg. from lower right corner, make 1 sc and previous 12 ch, 1 sc into top of previous st,

as indicated in chart. Loop: 1 sc, 11 ch, 1 sc, work back with 1 ch, 17 sc into loop, 1 sc into st at beg. 1 ch, break off yarn. Decoration - Make sheets with hdc into 16 st, as shown in chart. Shape letters with sc made into st of holder. **KETTLE HOLDER D** - 1st row: Make a chain of 21 st. Work back along chain with 1 ch and beg. with 2nd st from hook, make 1 sc into each st. 2nd-5th rows: 1 ch to turn and 1 sc into each st. 6th-6th rows: Dc; 2 st on each side (1 dc, at beg. of row; work back with 1 sc into last st, 1st row: 1 sc into each st. 7th row: 6 ch, then beg. with 2nd st from hook, make 1 sc into each st. To inc. at end of row, join another yarn with 1 sc into ch at beg. of 9th row and make 5 ch; finish 10th row with 5 sc into 1 ch from 1st row. 11th-40th rows: Cont. with blue yarn up to 27th row and finish with green yarn as shown in chart. Shells: Join green yarn to edge of 10th row and make 4 shells of 7 dc separated by 1 dc, then make loop with 1 sc, 14 ch, 1 sc, work back with 20 sc into loop, 1 sc, and break off yarn. Join yarn to other side of loop and make shell as shown in chart. Make the shells separately referring to the charts and attach with invisible st.
